




TURNING UP THE HEAT

GET OUTDOORS: COOMBE ABBEY

Located in Coventry, Coombe Abbey is perfect for a family day out, or a quiet little picnic. It's somewhere we used to love to visit back when we lived locally, so it was lovely to be able to take Rio and Marley together to have a wander around.

The park offers 500 acres of beautiful gardens, woodland, lakeside walks, and bird watching. There's also an onsite dogfriendly café and usually a funfair on site. Parking is cheap, with it costing around £1 per hour.

Coombe Abbey Park is a great place to bring your dog for a walk. It has vast areas of parkland available for exercising your dog both on and off the lead.

Bringing cash with you is advisable as there is no cash machine on site - many of the activities and refreshment stands on site do not accept card payments.



BENIDA: RESTRICTIONS

Restrictions are much more relaxed than they have been in very long time in Benidorm and the one that is most welcomed is perhaps the removal of masks outdoors. It is not compulsory to wear a mask outdoors now in Spain. However, the following restrictions are in place still in Benidorm:

- 1. Social meetings limited to 10 people.
- 2. Curfew from 1:00-6am.
- 3. Reduction of capacity in spectacles and celebrations in interiors, with a maximum of 1.500 people. All events must conclude at 00:30 pm.
- 4.In sports areas, their capacity is reduced by 50 %, with a maximum of 1.500 people.
- 5. The capacity in recreational pools is reduced by 50 %

Restrictions are in place until September 6th.


RIO PUPDATE

Before travelling back to the U.K, Rio needed a worming tablet at his local vets. This has to be signed in their EU passport or, if they're a British dog, on their medical certificate. This has to be taken between 24 hours and 5 days of crossing into the U.K.

We used the Eurotunnel to cross into the U.K, despite France being on the Amber plus list at the time, primarily because it's an easy option to cross with dogs and, at the time, the U.K wasn't accepting EU fully vaccinated certificates (which has since changed), so we would have had to quarantine and do the day 2 and day 8 tests anyway.

Since removing chicken from his diet, his skin has completely cleared up and he's having plenty of fun playing in the garden with Marley. It's so lovely to see him be able to play for so many hours and not be uncomfortable in the crazy August heat in Benidorm.



GOODBYE OUTDOOR MASKS!

On June 26th 2021, Spain removed the mandate for the compulsory use of masks outdoors and it felt absolutely amazing. Just to be able to breathe in fresh air again and see people's faces was a huge boost for seemingly everybody. It always felt a pointless task, especially in Benidorm, to wear a mask outdoors when walking down the street when there was absolutely nobody around at the time. The streets would be deserted or you'd be walking along the beach with zero chance of transmission as you were completely alone but still required to be masked up. Yet, if you were drinking or eating as you walked you didn't need to. It felt very bizarre.

There was a definite lift in mood when the announcement was made. There were, of course, a few moans and groans from a minority, but I am definitely on the side that it should be a choice and we should respect people's decision to wear or not wear a mask, especially when it comes to outdoors where there's plenty of scientific evidence to back that transmission is low outdoors and the use of masks isn't that important in curving infection rates.

I must say, coming back to England and not having to wear a mask indoors has felt rather strange at times. I have been apprehensive at times and have still worn my mask indoors in certain places where I have felt necessary, especially as I am pregnant.

TRAVELLING BACK TO ENGLAND


Before leaving Spain, whether you're a British citizen on holiday or an EU citizen, you need to take an antigen test to enter the U.K. This has to be taken within 3 days of entering British territory. The U.K government does advise taking a PCR, but this is not compulsory or law.

We had our antigen at the IMED Levante, where the results are returned to you within 20 minutes and all available online with a quick option to have it translated into English, Spanish, German or French. Although appointments are recommended, they do have a walk-in service. We opted to walk-in and within 10 minutes of walking in the hospital, we were walking back out again.

Like Spain, France has now lifted most of its restrictions. We didn't have any difficulties crossing the border and masks are only compulsory indoors. There isn't a curfew and we didn't need to provide a reason to travel or provide any documentation.

Within 48 hours of entering the U.K, you need to have your locator form and coronavirus test package booked. You cannot do this locator form early, it has to be done within the 48 hours. France and Spain are on the amber list so if you're not fully vaccinated you need a day 2 and 8 test with 10 days home quarantine. If you are fully vaccinated, you need a day 2 test with no quarantine necessary. Either one of these packages MUST be booked before attempting to enter British territory as you cannot complete the locator form without a booking reference for one. We used Regenerative Clinic for our tests, though we did have some teething problems.

The Eurotunnel was completely stress-free and the staff were all very friendly, which we've always found. At the time, France was amber plus so there was only four people on our crossing, I imagine it's busier again now!



C.C LA MARINA OPENS ITS TERRACE

We were thrilled to be invited to the opening of the terrace at Centro Comerical La Marina, Finestrat. The popular shopping centre is filled with some of my favourites like Bershka, Pull and Bear and Zara. You'll also find some other great places like C&A, Poundland (Dealz) and Ale Hop.

The newly renovated terrace is a bright and vibrant area of the shopping centre with bars, restaurants and entertainment for both adults and kids. On the same level, you'll also find a variety of kids play activities.

The grand opening of Terrace 1 of La Marina Finestrat Shopping Centre took place on Saturday 3rd July.

La Terraza has 3100 m2 of recently refurbished space with wonderful views of the skyline of Benidorm and Finestrat. This new space is equipped with shaded areas, a show and live music area, sunbathing areas and a wide range of restaurants. They also have the following restaurants: the well-known Mexican restaurant Cantina Mariachi, the Brasería Vaca Vieja, the new tapas bar Pan y Tapas, the popular Cervecería L'abadia and the charming truck converted into Azotea Bar.

On Saturday 14th August 2021, we celebrated our baby shower with plenty of friends and family. All of the people visited took a rapid test before they came to help keep everybody as safe as possible and we had an amazing day.

I planned the majority of the baby shower, with the help of Alex and my mum and dad. We went for a pastel themed elephant party which I'm sure you'll all agree was very me!

The cake was made by Julie, a friend of my dad's, which was a delicious two tier naked cake topped with raspberries, strawberries and blueberries. The topper was an icing elephant with pink elements. We also had a biscuit, brownie, scone and cupcake assortment from a local business in Leicestershire. My dad then did a BBQ in the afternoon with hog roast rolls, chicken drumsticks, hotdogs and nibbles.

For our early guests, I prepared a little gift bag filled with sweets, a succulent to grow alongside our little one, party games, a pink pen, the scan photo made into a mini chocolate bar, a baby bottle filled with more sweets, a pink candle, a mini rattle, a wooden elephant with "gracias por venir, Baby Joy" engraved on which means "thanks for coming" in Spanish.

The day went really well despite the rain that poured just as it began, it really was a baby shower! Thankfully, we had a few areas undercover in the garden with a marquee set up and a pegola with some seating below. The balloon arch stayed in tact and things went relatively smoothly!

I'm hoping everybody had as great day as we did, we're so glad we were able to celebrate in real life with friends and family and we're super grateful for such lovely gifts, she's already so spoilt!



DAY 5 TEST TO RELEASE WITH DAM HEALTH

As I'm not fully vaccinated, and France was on the Amber Plus list, we were subject to a 10 day quarantine. We took advantage of shortening our quarantine on Day 5 by taking a test at the Dam Health clinic in Leicester. We took our test in the clinic at 12:30 and by 21:00 our PCR results had returned and allowed us to end our quarantine period.

The service was quick, efficient and we didn't have any problems in terms of chasing up results or chasing actual test packages to arrive like we had, neither did we have any problems in terms of wait times and result times like others had reported with other companies.

DAM Health actually have clinics in Spain too, which means you can make use of their services with the return to the UK fit to fly, or other tests if they are required, like non-vaccinated wanting to visit other places in the EU from Spain.

There are two clinics in Benidorm, one on Av Emilio Ortuño and another on Av. Castelló. They offer PCR tests from 99€ and Antigen tests from 39€. The cheapest PCR provides results the next day, and the emergency PCR and Antigen tests provide results by midnight,

'GALAXIA HUNG' EXTENDS ITS STAY IN BENIDORM UNTIL MID-SEPTEMBER

'Galaxia Hung', the colorful sculpture exhibition by Taiwanese artist Hung-Yi, will spend the summer in Benidorm. The mayor, Toni Pérez, and the Councilor for Historical and Cultural Heritage, Ana Pellicer, has announced that "the exhibition extends its stay in our city until mid-September, enabling residents to enjoy this exhibition, and so the tourists who visit us this summer will be able to appreciate it".

Taking advantage of this 'extra' exhibition period, and in coordination with the artist himself and the exhibition curator, Eduardo Alcalde, one of the most iconic and photographed sculptures from 'Hung Galaxy' will move to the Poniente area, one of the most touristic points of the city during the high season".

The pair of swans that currently presides over Plaza de SSMM Reyes de España will move to Avenida Armada Española, at an intermediate point on Paseo de Poniente.

"Hung Galaxy" exhibition arrived in Benidorm on April 16. Initially, the show was scheduled to be in the city until July 12, a date that is now being extended by two more months.

Since the arrival, the City Council has promoted a popular photography contest and a drawing contest among the little ones. The six best snapshots from the photography contest complement the Taiwanese artist's sculpture exhibition and are on display at l'Espai d'Art Urbà El Pont.

ALEX'S COOKING CORNER

MEXICAN BAKED SWEET POTATO WITH **BLACK BEANS**

Sweet potatoes

1 tin of black beans 70g Brown rice (cooked according to packet) feel free to use a microwave pack 150g Grated cheese 60g Cherry tomatoes (quartered) 1 Spring onion (thinly sliced)

1 Small green chilli (thinly sliced)

Olive oil, salt and pepper

You could always add some mince meat too

if you want or an avocado



HOW TO

Jacket spud is a go to meal for when you can't be bothered to cook as it does itself really. This one is almost just as easy but is totally different.

- 1. Preheat the oven to 220/fan 200/ gas mark 7 and line the baking tray with baking paper or tin foil.
- 2. Cut the sweet potato in half lengthways, rub with oil and place cut side down on tray. Season with salt and pepper and roast for 25 minutes until very tender.
- 3. In a small bowl toss beans, rice and cheese, then spoon over cooked potatoes. Return to oven to slightly melt cheese and warm through.
- 4. Once cheese is melted remove potatoes and top with tomatoes, onion and chilli. Season with salt and pepper to serve.
- 5. Add more cheese!!!! (If you wish).

Jacket spuds with a kick. As ever mix and match with what you have and like. I go by sight so how much of an ingredient you use, use your judgment and what I have put as a guide rather than a rule.

TASTY TAPAS

ENSALADILLA RUSA "RUSSIAN POTATO SALAD"



It's one of the most common dishes in any Spanish tapas bar, and you either love it or hate it. I am not a fan of potato salad anyway, so I'm not here to fight the corner for the Russian salad, but many people rave about it being light and refreshing especially in the summer months. If you do like a potato salad, I'm going to hazard a guess that you'll enjoy this staple tapas dish.

In Spain, your typical ensaladilla rusa recipe includes potatoes, peas, and carrots, and it is typical to add tuna as well. In some places, especially southern Spain like Seville and Cadiz, they sometimes add shrimp and hard boiled egg.

Despite the Russian name, ensaladilla Rusa has become as Spanish as you can get, and is an important dish in Spain's culinary history.

It is commonly eaten as a starter or appetiser.

Palau d'Esports Pool Closed


l'Illa de Benidorm will remain closed until the end of the month "to undertake maintenance services and scheduled improvement works," as reported by the Sports Councilor, Mariló Cebreros. The objective, she specified, "is to be perfectly operational for the beginning of courses and activities in September."

PCR OR ANTIGEN?

Many people have been asking whether it's compulsory to have a PCR test taken in Spain to return to the U.K.

You do not need to have a PCR in Spain to return to the U.K, an antigen, which is much cheaper is perfectly acceptable. It is only recommended to take a PCR, not the law to take one.

Anybody over the age of 12 who is returning to the UK from Spain must take a test in Spain to return, regardless of whether you are fully vaccinated or not. All fully-vaccinated passengers entering the UK must book a day 2 PCR to take when back in the U.K but no quarantine is required. Those who aren't fully vaccinated must self-isolate for 10 days and book a day 2 and day 8 PCR.

We also enjoyed the evening entertainment, even though it was currently adapted to appease COVID restrictions. We'd 100% visit again, giving it a thumbs up for both families with young children and teens or for those who might need more in terms of special adaptations.

NUESTRA LADY PILAR

The first church dedicated to Mary in history.

The Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar (Spanish: Catedral-Basílica de Nuestra Señora del Pilar) is a Roman Catholic church in the city of Zaragoza, Aragon (Spain).

The church of Our Lady of the Pilar in Zaragoza, is the first church dedicated to Mary in history and it remains standing to this day, having survived invasions and wars – in the Spanish Civil War of 1936-1939 three bombs were dropped on the church, fortunately none of them exploded.

Today, the Basilica de Nuestra Senora del Pilar, as it is formally known, includes 11 brightly colored tiled domes and is the second biggest church in Spain (only the cathedral in Seville is larger). construction was begun in 1681 under the direction of King Charles II.

The beautiful cathedral is well worth a visit and makes for absoliutely stunning photos, no matter what the angle.


